Farmers' Electric Cooperative, Inc. of New Mexico Announces New Chief Executive Officer

The Farmers' Electric Cooperative (FEC) Board of Trustees has selected Antonio Sanchez Jr. as the Cooperative's new Chief Executive Officer (CEO). Mr. Sanchez was selected from a field of more than thirty candidates for the position and will report to the FEC Headquarters Office (Clovis) starting May 23, 2022. Mr. Sanchez has significant experience in the electric cooperative industry, employed by Roosevelt County Electric Cooperative (RCEC), Portales, for more than twenty-two years. Mr. Sanchez has served the membership of RCEC as Engineering Manager and General Manager & Executive Vice-President. He is a licensed, Professional Engineer in the states of Colorado, New Mexico, and Texas. Mr. Sanchez takes over from Lance R. Adkins, retiring in early June, following a 42-year career with FEC.
